Discussion/Comments: General Manager Ramirez reported the District joined OMNIA Partners co-op purchasing group to save \$1300/\$668 a week or \$30k per year. He reported Engineering Tech interviews will be held on Dec. 12th. He also reported Casey Construction finished Willow Pump Station, but was waiting for the new generator and fencing. Casey Construction will continue to the Stowe Lane Pump Station next. Ramirez continued to report eight manholes in downtown Menlo Park have been baited for rodents. He also reported there will be a report to the Board on the Levee Project on January 8th. The next regular meetings are scheduled for Dec. 18th and Jan. 8th. The complete General Manager's written report is in the December 11, 2024, agenda packet.

Discussion/Comments: General Manager Ramirez reported 4.6MG of reclaimed water was processed and 530K were delivered. He also reported staff performed some unexpected repairs which included air diffusers and pipe brackets. The work was performed in-house.

10. Discussion and Direction on Bayfront Recycled Water Project and Status Update

Discussion/Comments: General Manager Ramirez reported Levee Project Phase II is 65% complete. The next step is planting the ecotone and clarifying entrance improvements. He also reported there will be a Bayfront Recycled Water Facility Project update from the Design Build team at the December 18th Board meeting. Project Management proposal was reduced from \$2.2M to \$1.6M and the final Construction Design Build cost for phase II was reduced from \$85.6M to \$84.7M, reducing the overall cost of the project by \$1.5M combined.

11. Report, Discussion and Direction on South Bayside Waste Management Authority (SBWMA) including Solid Waste Franchise Re-Assignment

Discussion/Comments: President Dehn introduced SBWMA Executive Director, Joe La Mariana. Mr. La Mariana gave a brief update on SBWMA projects.

Subject: General Manager's Report

1) Administrative:

- a. The District was awarded the Collection System of the Year award from the California Water Environment Association's local chapter. The local chapter represents San Mateo and Santa Clara Counties. The award will be received at its January Awards Dinner and the application will continue to the State level. The District will then compete against sanitary districts and public works departments from around the State.
- b. An emergency was declared at the Flow Equalization Resource Recovery Facility (FERRF) due to the King Tides combined with recent rains. The Menlo Park access road to the facility was approximately one foot from being breached and the District's levee was approximately two feet from being breached but is currently under construction. Blocks and sandbags were placed at the entrance to the FERRF to protect the site.

2) Finance:

- a. The Financial Audit was approved by the full Board on December 11.

3) CIP Projects:

a. Capital Improvement Program (CIP):

- i. The Bayfront Recycled Water Facility construction is going well. Now that a fee has been established for the use of the facility, the District will offer the reclaimed water on a first come first serve basis and will resume discussions with local developers and agencies.

b. Levee Improvement Project:

- i. Anderson Pacific is working on the second phase of the levee project. The Ecotone portion of the levee should be completed by the end of January. Our permitting consultant will attempt to clear the site of restrictions by conducting a nesting survey and communicating with the regulators. This could allow for construction to continue into February and beyond.

c. Point Repair Project Phase II:

- i. Casey Construction continues to replace numerous pipe segments as part of the Phase II Point Repair Project and is nearly finished.

d. Telemetry Replacement Project:

- i. Blocka Construction began the Telemetry Replacement Project. The project includes replacing the alarm and remote monitoring systems at twelve pump station sites. Replacement should begin in early 2025.

- 4) **Information Technology (IT):**
 - a. Staff continues to update the East Palo Alto Sanitary District (EPASD) database and will prepare work orders through Lucity in order to track maintenance history and assets.
- 5) **Operations and Maintenance:**
 - a. **Collection System:**
 - i. District crews will begin to maintain the EPASD system on January 2, 2025.
 - b. **Pump Facilities:**
 - i. Field site visits were conducted by Blocka Construction and parts have been ordered for the telemetry project.
 - c. **Training:**
 - i. Five new Maintenance Workers continue their on-board training.
- 6) **Water Quality:**
 - a. **Sharon Heights Golf and Country Club (SHGCC):**
 - i. The facility will produce reclaimed water at the lowest level to keep the biology in the plant healthy.
 - b. **Bayfront Recycled Water Facility (BRWF):**
 - i. The Parkline - SRI developer inquired about the recycled water pipeline for their project. The District may consider fast tracking the design.
- 7) **Fleet and Facilities:**
 - a. **Vehicle Maintenance:**
 - i. Staff will draft a staff report to add vehicles to the fleet to support the East Palo Alto interagency agreement.
- 8) **Personnel:**
 - i. Recruitment for an Engineering Technician is underway. Interviews were scheduled for December 12. Two top candidates will attend a second-round interview.
- 9) **Upcoming Events:**
 - a. **Next Regular Board Meetings:** Wednesdays, December 18, 2024, and January 8, 2025.
- 10) **Misc. Items:**
 - a. **West Bay:** The General Manager will update the Board on miscellaneous items related to District operations.
 - b. **Town of Los Altos Hills:** Staff continue to maintain the collection system and contribute to CIP recommendations.
 - c. **Town of Woodside:** Staff continues to maintain the Town's pump stations and collection system. The final High Frequency (Hot Spot) schedule for the year was conducted in downtown area.
 - d. **East Palo Alto:** The United States, Environmental Protection Agency will visit the EPA Sanitary District on December 18, 2024. They are following up on a 2021 inspection and will be focusing on the collection system performance and its assets, similar to the 2021 visit.

Subject: *Consider Authorizing the General Manager to Enter into a Purchase Order Agreement for an IBAK CCTV Unit, US Jetter and Ford Maverick Hybrid*

Background

In July of 2024 the District entered into an agreement with the City of East Palo Alto to operate and maintain their sewer collection system similar to the Los Altos Hills (LAH) and Town of Woodside (TOW.) As a result, with these agreements, staff has requested that we purchase an IBAK CCTV Unit, US Jetter ½” and a Ford Maverick Hybrid to support the contracts.

According to the Purchasing Policy, cooperative purchase agreements can be utilized to provide financial benefits to the District when purchasing equipment, furniture, vehicles, etc. The District recognizes cooperatives such as Source well (Formerly NJPA) National Joint Powers Alliance, California Multiple Awards Schedule (CMAS), General Services Administration (GSA), California State Bids, H-GAC (Houston-Galveston Area Council) cooperative and other multi-government agency agreements.

Analysis

Staff will perform preventative maintenance cleaning, CCTV video inspections, Fats Oil & Grease inspections, and other services to assess the East Palo Alto Sanitary District’s collection system. CCTV inspections are also performed for the LAH and TOW’s interagency maintenance contracts. The CCTV video inspections are also used to verify the cleaning crews are cleaning line segments properly as part of our on-going Quality Control (Q/C) as described in agency Sewer System Management Plans.

District staff spent several months analyzing the latest technology in CCTV inspection equipment and found that numerous improvements have been made in the past ten years. Staff had four separate vendors demonstrate their latest equipment and technology options and IBAK proved to perform the best as it has an advanced Ultra HD 4K picture quality with twin digital cameras in one unit. The IBAK panoramic camera system provides high-definition imagery and can help increase CCTV inspection efficiency. The control room includes an ergonomic keyboard, touch screen controls, joystick camera controls, and 22” monitors. By purchasing a second IBAK unit, the district gain efficiency and will not be required to purchase additional IKAS

software, saving approximately \$9,600 on software. The IKAS software integrates well with the district's GIS and Lucity. The new system includes two separate cameras. The smaller steerable tractor with lift which can inspect from 6" to 24" pipe. The tractor is versatile enough to maneuver around voids and maneuver over offsets. The equipment records in High-Definition. The 360-degree panorama camera can scan 6" to 12" pipes and allows for more efficient coding. IBAK is developing the ability to use AI pipe coding in the future. The CCTV Unit will be mounted on a 16' Ford E450 gas powered chassis.

The District obtained a bid for the purchase of the CCTV Unit through Sourcewell and Jack Doheny Company (JDC) for \$463,393.82. Staff was not able to obtain a third quote for the IBAK unit because JAC is the only Northern California Supplier. However, utilizing this cooperative purchasing program ensures the District receives a competitive price for the equipment.

The District obtained two quotes one for a 1/2" US Jetter on an 2025 Isuzu electric chassis for \$251,784.09 and the other for a 1/2" US Jetter on a 2025 Isuzu diesel chassis for \$184,950.62. The unit will have 800' of 1/2" hose, 600 gallons of water. At this point the electric Isuzu is still not feasible nor competitive.

The District's Electric Fleet Plan requires us to diversify our fleet to include Hybrid Vehicles. Staff obtained two quotes for a Ford Maverick Hybrid from National Auto Fleet Group (Co-Op) for \$31,317.85 and the second direct quote from Towne Ford for \$29,742.53, a savings of \$1,575.32 by using the local dealer.

Fiscal Impact

The price for the second CCTV Unit (IBAK) through Sourcewell is \$463,393.82 including sales tax. The price for the 1/2" US Jetter on the Isuzu Diesel chassis is \$184,950.62 and the price for the Ford Maverick Hybrid is \$29,742.53.

The District budgeted \$712,000 for these purchases on December 11, 2024. The three proposed units will not exceed \$678,086.97. An additional 3% contingency or \$20,000.00 will be required to purchase safety-traffic lights, radio equipment, and other miscellaneous tools for all three units. The total cost will not exceed \$698,086.97 including contingency.

There will be no fiscal impact to the District's General Budget as these units will be funded by the interagency agreements.

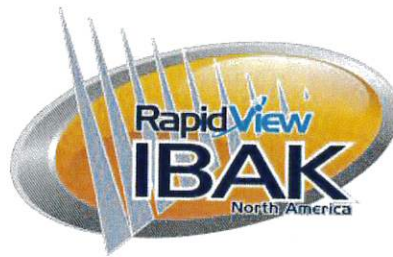
Recommendation

The Assistant Operations Superintendent recommends the Board authorize the General Manager to enter into a Purchase Order Agreement with JDC through Sourcewell for an IBAK CCTV Unit, Weco Industries for a ½"US Jetter, and with Towne Ford a Ford Maverick Hybrid.
